

Post Master's Adult-Gero Nurse Practitioner Certificate Program

The Adult-Gero Primary Care Nurse Practitioner certificate program is designed for individuals prepared with a Bachelor of Science in Nursing and a Master's of Science in Nursing who wish to gain specialty knowledge in this role. Students must proceed through the admission process including interview with other candidates for the Adult-Gero Primary Care Nurse Practitioner track.

The certificate consists of adult-gero primary care nurse practitioner courses. The program totals 20 credit hours and can be completed in 3 consecutive semesters (including summer semester).

PLEASE NOTE: Student must complete advanced pathophysiology, advanced physical assessment and advanced pharmacology prior to beginning clinical courses. An individual program of study will be developed by the advisor based on previous coursework.

*Practicum courses equal 660 clock hours. Clock hours are calculated using a 1:4 ratio (1 credit hour = 4 clock hours) multiplied by 15 practicum weeks per semester.
